

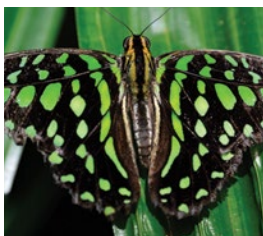

Niagara Falls is truly in the middle of it all, so living here means never being at a loss for what to do. From renowned outdoor adventures to culinary delights to great shopping opportunities, the city has something to suit everyone’s interests.

Historic downtown Niagara Falls is an especially unique spot, popular among locals and tourists alike. Take a stroll to admire architecture dating back to the 1850s and then duck into a cute café for a cup of java and some people watching. Test your skills at an escape room before hopping on a bike and

enjoying a leisurely ride along Queen Street and beyond. Or, head to the shores of Lake Erie to relax for an afternoon on one of the many beautiful beaches like Crystal Beach.

Niagara Falls is situated on the east side of the Niagara region, nestled against the western shore of the Niagara River and just minutes from the U.S. border, Welland, St. Catharines, and Niagara-on-the-Lake. If you want to get out of the city for a bit (but really, why would you?!), hop on the highway and you’re 25 minutes from Crystal Beach, less than an hour from Hamilton, and about 90 minutes from downtown Toronto.





THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Want to get outside and enjoy the fresh air? Niagara Falls has a lot more to offer than just its namesake cascade!

PARKS AND TRAILS

The **Niagara Parks Botanical Gardens** was established in the 1930s and boasts 99 acres of picture-perfect gardens, including the world-famous rose garden. You'll also find the **Butterfly Conservatory** on these grounds, where you can take a self-guided walking tour to admire over 2,000 beautiful butterflies.

If you're in the mood for adventure, head over to the **Niagara Glen Nature Centre**. Enjoy gorgeous views of the Niagara River while hiking (or bouldering) through four kilometres of trails in the Carolinian forest and the Niagara River Whirlpool.

Kingsbridge Park and **Queen Victoria Park** offer quieter settings for family time. The former has picnic pavilions, walking trails, and a playground for the kids, while the latter sits across from Horseshoe Falls and is the perfect spot to admire manicured gardens and beautiful blooms.

And speaking of blooms, **Centennial Lilac Garden** can't be missed in the early summer. Throughout May and June, more than 1,200 plants of over 200 varieties burst into colour for a spectacular sight. With plenty of walking trails nearby, you can make an afternoon of it!

For a completely unique experience, try the **White Water Walk**. Relax and revel in a calm walk alongside swirling class VI rapids. Don't forget your camera, because the scenery is nothing short of stunning!

CONSERVATION AREAS

Dufferin Islands Nature Area is home to the Winter Festival of Lights. But it's no less enjoyable in the warmer weather, with 10 acres of natural beauty and wooden footbridges to connect the islands.

In nearby Niagara-on-the-Lake, you'll find **Woodend Conservation Area**, which was an observation point throughout the War of 1812. Enjoy panoramic views of the Niagara Escarpment and Lake Ontario—and see how many species you can identify in the hardwood and Carolinian forest.

CYCLING

If you love a good bike ride, you'll be thrilled with what Niagara Falls has to offer. The city has an extensive network of cycling trails, including the 53-kilometre **Niagara River Recreation Trail**. Admire views of the Niagara Glen and Whirlpool as you wind your way to Niagara-on-the-Lake.

The **Greater Niagara Circle Route** also passes through Niagara Falls. This paved, 140-kilometre trail will take you through seven municipalities in the Niagara region. It's also a favourite among rollerbladers, so be sure to share the path!

FIREMEN'S PARK

Then, navigate tightropes, cargo nets, and swinging logs as you make your way through the Whirlpool Adventure Course.

ENTERTAINMENT

In Niagara Falls, the **Avalon Theatre** at Fallsview Casino is your go-to place for a night on the town. It boasts 5,000 seats, state-of-the-art technology, and incredible acoustics—so it's no wonder performers like REO Speedwagon, Allison Krauss, and Jason Derulo have graced the stage. The **Niagara Falls Convention Centre** plays just as hard, hosting sporting events, concerts, and other special events.

If you're big on betting, **Fallsview Casino** and **Casino Niagara** are where you'll want to be. Fallsview offers over 3,000 slot machines and 130 gaming tables, plus a full resort with spa, shops, meeting space, and dining options that include two CAA/AAA Four Diamond award-winning restaurants. Casino Niagara features two floors of gaming with 1,500 slot machines, 45 table games, and great dining options.

Looking for a laugh? Head to **Yuk Yuk's** at the Four Points hotel. This adults-only standup comedy

venue is always a top pick for a fun night out, featuring a huge range of comedians plus snack foods and bar service.

And what would Niagara Falls be without magic, music, and dining in Clifton Hill? The **Greg Frewin Theatre** lies in the heart of the district and offers Frewin's Vegas-style magic show, plus a host of other special concerts and comedy events throughout the year.

If the kids are coming along, try **Strike Bowling & Games**. With 14 full-size bowling lanes, high-tech arcade games and racing simulators, and billiard tables, we're willing to bet that you'll be back here more than once!

ESSENTIALS & SHOPPING

For all your essential needs, head to **Niagara Square**. It's home to everything from Dollarama and Michael's to Winners and JYSK, and it's adjacent to **Costco** and **Costco Gas**. Just across the street is **SmartCentres Niagara Falls**, where you'll find Walmart, LCBO, Bulk Barn, PetSmart, and more.

The downtown area has plenty to offer if you want to shop small and

support local businesses, including florists, bakeries, health food shops, cafés, and thrift stores.

FITNESS & RECREATION

Fitness enthusiasts won't be disappointed with the variety of facilities on offer in Niagara Falls. Big names like LA Fitness thrive alongside locally owned fitness centres, yoga studios, CrossFit gyms, and other wellness businesses.

The **MacBain Community Centre** offers an array of recreation programs, including pickleball, drop-in basketballs, and an indoor walking track. Older adults are welcome to use the **Coronation 50 Plus Recreation Centre** programming, such as fitness classes, friendship group, watercolour painting, and drop-in bridge.

Gale Centre Arena boasts four NHL-size rinks that often play host to hockey tournaments—but you can rent out the ice if you're looking for a unique activity with family or friends. The arena also offers skate sharpening, concessions, and meeting rooms.

The city has five pools and seven splash pads for summer fun. Pub-





lic classes include swimming lessons for both children and adults, aqua fit classes, and swim team. The city's two arenas—Gale Centre and Chippawa Willoughby Memorial Arena—play host to various sports practices and events and are also available for private bookings.

FESTIVALS

While Niagara Falls hosts plenty of events all year round, its most famous festival is the **Winter Festival of Lights**. It's the country's largest free outdoor light festival, featuring spectacular displays with millions of lights. Taking place from November to February each year, you can drive the festival route or bundle up and walk to see the displays up close.

If you're an Elvis fan, you won't want to miss the four-day **Niagara Falls Elvis Festival**, featuring some of the top tribute artists in the world. And comic lovers and creators will love the **Niagara Falls Comic Con**, with exhibitors, comic books, movie cars, celebrities, a video gaming arena, and more.

In nearby Niagara-on-the-Lake, the **Peach Festival** sweetens up summer. Each August, local growers descend on Queen Street with their goods in tow. Enjoy pies, preserves, and, of course, good old peaches.

GOLF

Ready to hit the green? The **Niagara Falls Golf Club** is ready for you! The course is open year-

round (weather permitting) and features 18 holes with a rolling landscape, wooded areas, and numerous bunkers and ponds.

Whirlpool Golf Course is one of the top public courses in Canada for a reason. Set along the Niagara River Whirlpool and Niagara Gorge, it offers an 18-hole championship course with generous fairways and few water hazards (save for its signature 2nd hole).

And then there's **Legends on the Niagara**, with two championship courses plus a par-3 executive course, a 360-degree driving range, an incredible training academy, and excellent clubhouse facilities.

GET YOUR **FOODIE** ON

It's hard to top Niagara falls when it comes to the food scene!

If you're a master in your own kitchen, you may want to head to the **Niagara Falls Farmers Market**. It's held at the MacBain Community Centre every Saturday from May to October and features farm and artisanal products from local vendors.

RESTAURANTS

Heading out for a meal? You'll be spoiled for choice in Niagara Falls.

The Niagara region's culinary scene is vibrant and diverse. You'll find everything from classic steakhouses and rustic Italian eateries to mouthwatering tacos and delectable dessert. For delicious seafood there's **Tide and Vine**. If a steakhouse is more your thing, enjoy the stunning views of the Falls from **Morton's**

Grille Niagara Falls. Other local favourites include **Ponte Vecchio**, **Danny's Sushi**, and **Weinkeller**. Of course, the city also has all the usual suspects, including chains like McDonald's, Tim Hortons, and Pizza Pizza.

When you're ready to treat your sweet tooth, take your pick of local bakeries, gelato shops, and ice cream parlours. Or opt for a delicious BeaverTail while you admire the Falls at night.

WINERIES

Niagara is renowned for its wines, so it's no surprise that Niagara Falls is home to some outstanding wineries.

In the city, you'll find two options to visit. **Lundy Manor Wine Cellars** sits on a sprawling, 60-acre property and grows Riesling and hybrid grapes to produce

100% Niagara VQA wines. **Monastery Cellars** has an on-site vineyard and produces small-lot vintages of premium VQA wines. It's known for its ice wines, which you can try at the tasting bar after touring the vineyard and exploring the gorgeous grounds.

Just a short drive from Niagara Falls sit numerous other wineries, including Konzelmann Estate, Wayne Gretzky Estates, Perridiso Estate Winery, and Inniskillin Wines.

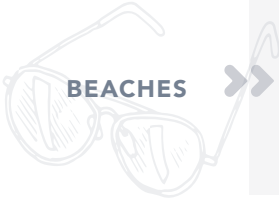

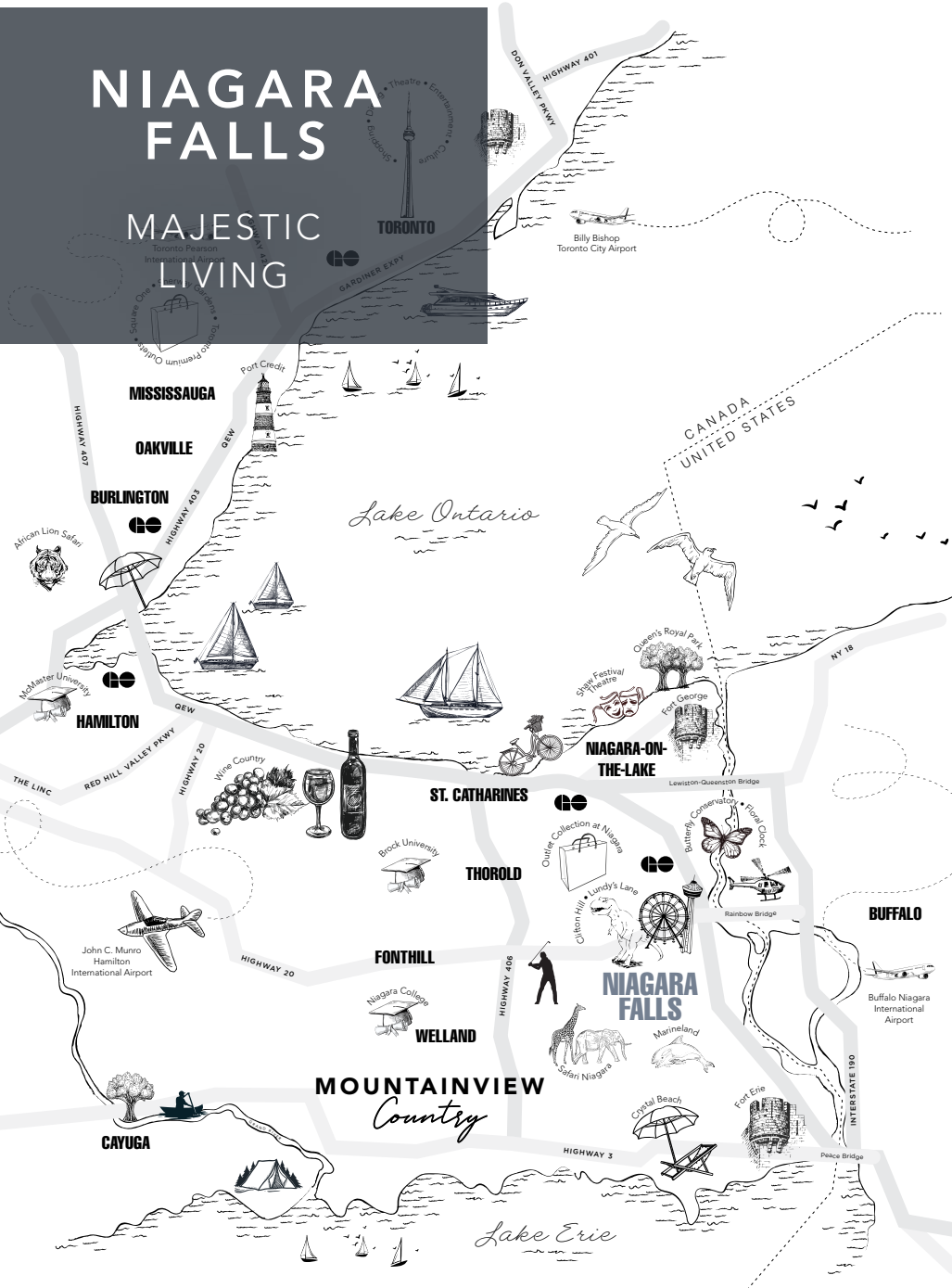
